About Habitat ReStore: ReStore is a home goods resale store that accepts donations and sells home goods to the public at a fraction of the retail price. Proceeds of items sold at ReStore directly support the mission of Habitat; to build safe, decent and financially sustainable housing.

Job Summary: Manages donor experience from pick up of items, to tax receipt. Provides positive experience that encourages donors to reschedule. Ensure items are acceptable as per HFHDC standards. Ensures safety protocols and procedures are followed. Manages truck adherence to assigned pick up schedule. Communicates any schedule changes or adjustments with Customer Service & Reach Supervisor. Assist in removal of items from truck once at store loading dock. Maintain truck and inform Senior Truck Driver and Donations Supervisor of any issues with truck.

Responsibilities:

Volunteers: Work with volunteers to successfully load and unload donations at loading dock, or on truck when applicable, maintain positive and safe working environment.

Staff: Work with Truck Associate to maintain timely pick up schedule, maintain safe and positive working environment

Truck: Load and unload donated materials, Screen for product usability, Communicate with Back End Supervisor regarding incoming donations, Drive HFHDC vehicles to pick up and deliver donated goods Operate heavy machinery, Keep ReStore Truck clean and sanitary, ensure safety procedures are followed on truck and at donation locations
